Due to COVID19 restrictions our meetings will now be on Zoom, instead of visiting various RSL. Our computers and I phones have become tools, for communication and hopefully our skills have improved as a result.

ADF have yet again shown their strength in not only bushfire crisis, but also the pandemic. Skills that are rarely seen on home turf, due to mainly overseas aid, their achievements tend to go unnoticed.

VVAA Museum Peace Garden, where several of the Units have already funded and arranged for their individual plaques. This site has become a real tourist attraction and with the support of Vets donations, local council, along with state government aid it will progress even further.

Emails have been circulating again regarding the Fire Support Base Andersen. The battle of Nui Le, has also had recent publicity.

During the Tet Offensive of February 1968 [Year of The Monkey], the Viet Cong and NVA made numerous fierce assaults on the joint Australian, New Zealand and American Manned Fire Support Base Andersen near the village of Trang Bom, east of Bien Hoa, on the north-easterly outskirts of Saigon. It was the first time 1 ATF had operated outside of Phuoc Tuy Province and was AOP Coburg. Although the first Australian forces into Vietnam including RAEME operatives from 101 and 1 Fld Sqdn Wksps worked from Bien Hoa. The ATF deliberately established FSBs astride the busy Communist lines of communication, expecting that the enemy would attempt to destroy them. 3 Btn. RAR, Aust Kiwi & US Arty, A Sqdn 3 Cavalry, 3 Trp 1 Fld Sqdn along with 2 RAEME 1Fld Wksp members. During the battle of 17/18 Feb. the VC/NVA attacked with typical ferocity. As part of AOP Coburg FSB Harrison was established closer to Bien Hoa. Tragically, an overnight standing patrol comprising of No.11 Section 3 Trp. 1 Fld Sqdn RAE 10 Sappers, Staff Sergeant, a lance Corporal acting in the role of infantry, were earlier sent outside the wire to a rocky knoll feature some 300 mtrs. from the FSB. To provide an early listening post, important to detect advancing enemy. During early morning enemy assaults, the patrol received direct hits from mortar and RPG fire and was virtually wiped out without any communications back to FSB. The FSB could not call in extra arty support as there were coordinated attacks on other close bases. Four of the Sappers were KIA and three others wounded. In the FSB 2 3 RAR riflemen, one Australian and one American Artilleryman were KIA. A large number were WIA. In a cruel twist of fate, two of the surviving sappers were to be KIA just one month later, in a mine incident during Operation Pinaroo in the Long Hai Mountains within Phuoc Tuy province, S/E of Nui Dat. Dark days indeed for the proud men of 3 Troop of 1 Fld Sqdn RAE.

In May 1968 Balmoral, Coogee and Coral FSBs were established east of FSB Andersen, north of Bien Hoa and Tan Uyen, where the Battle of Coral took place. Tet Offensive of February 1969 saw Australian forces return to a similar area not too far from "Andersen".
