The day had reasonable attendance for Valentines Day. Next year it has been requested that the Shrine move the day to the Sunday after.

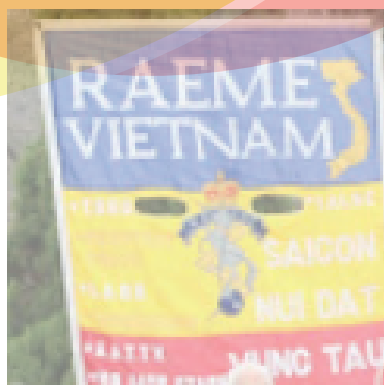

RAEME Victoria - MEMBERSHIP BLUE BELLS REPORT

Late 1971 saw Australian – New Zealand forces end combat duties and withdraw the First Australian Task Force from the base at Nui Dat.

Some of the equipment gleaned from other allied forces had to be disposed of. The 1 Field Squadron Workshop Caterpillar 12 grader, (complete with RAEME TAC sign) & which was the newest and best conditioned unit was cut up and destroyed. A diesel engine was placed in the dam. The workshop still managed RTA extra equipment. One of the D8 dozers was RTA, with a cracked engine block and track frame after meeting with very high explosive. The operator had his head out the observation hole in the cabin roof, catching fresh air, sitting on the oil tank controlling the “levers” with his feet. He survived the blast. This took place when clearing one of our minefields.

In this edition we have two photos taken within the Phuoc Tuy province during the Land Clearing Operation at Long Hai Mountain range. The first is from a helicopter, which had to hover above, while fire from Australian 105 Howitzers at the Long Greens, pounded the hills. You can pick out two rounds in the air, hopefully low enough to miss the Iroquois.



The second is Caterpillar D8H Number 4 [Acre – eater] The drab olive colour helps to disguise amongst the scrub at the base of the Long Hai range. The area to be cleared was broken up in



smaller sections which were alphabetically titled. They weren't cleared in any particular order, which prevented the enemy from reading the “play”. Land clearing was carried out by both Engineer units 17 Construction and 1 Field Sqns. The construction of the Nui Dat dam was another Joint project. There were 15 Low Speed size 6 with Angle ozer Blade [Rome Plow] and winch. There were Low Speed Size 6 with Dozer Blade [Bull Blade] and Ripper. U.S. Land Clearing Team used D7E Caterpillar Bulldozers and later D9.

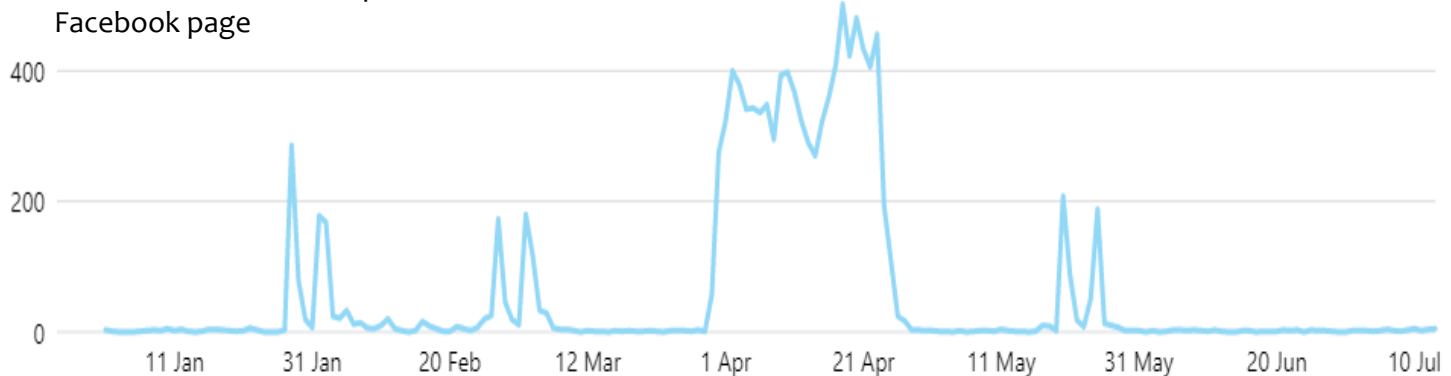


The Power of Social Media -

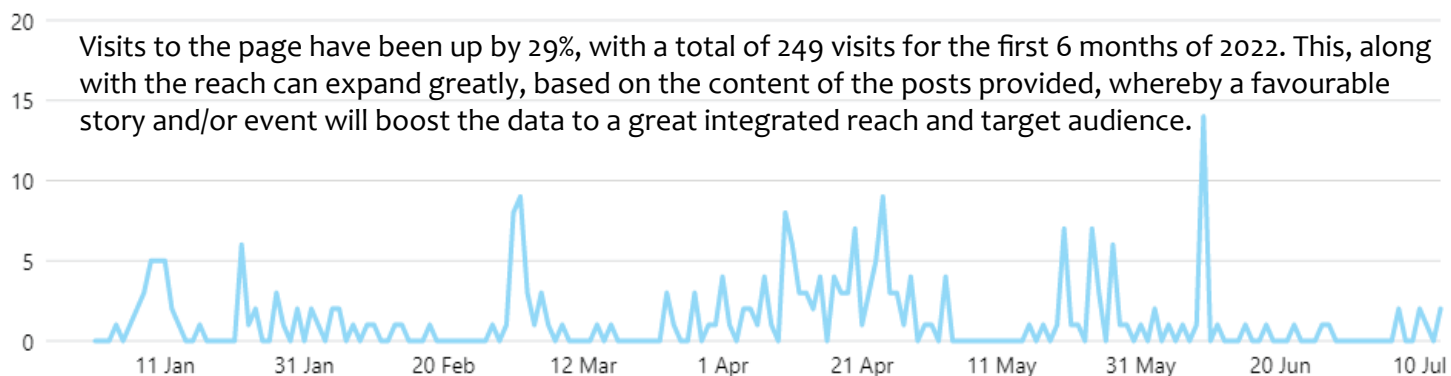
