RAEME Vietnam Southern Chapter held last meeting at Bell Park RSL Vasey House. Firstly, we must thank Graeme Unmack [Ferret] for organizing the meeting and following a quite an

50th Year Anniversary of Operation Hammersley. One of the last major ANZAC Battles.

1 Armoured Regiment celebrated it at a Service at The Canberra National War Memorial.

April 1969 saw a major land clearing operation start at the base of the foothills of the Long Hai mountain range just west of Long Dien. The area was broken up into alphabetical squares.

It was then cleared in a non- sequential fashion to create an un – predictable programme of operation, in an attempt to confuse the enemy located in the hills.

The Hammersley operation began on 10th February 1970 when C company of the Eighth Battalion; Royal Australian Regiment with 1 Field Engineer Squadron Splinter teams, Centurion tank, APC and mortar support with some of the carriers to the western side of the Long Hai mountain range, known as the Minh Dam Secret Zone. An alternative site, to the quarry established on Nui Dat One Hill within the Task Force base. Quarry operations were to be developed by 17 Construction Engineer Squadron. Fire Support Base “Isa” was established by C Company.

After a number of successful ambushes, the Company had continued contact with the local VC D445 battalion, who relied on supply from local villages. The operation became quite large with good use of the tanks and APCs to mobilise and give the infantry protection. There was also artillery support from the nearby “Horseshoe” fire support base. Both RAEME ARVs were involved during the operation, including recovering an APC, which was hit with an RPG, caught fire and later a satchel chard thrown into the vehicle killing the crew. A very large cache of ammunition, RPGs, launchers, grenades and weapons were captured from the enemy. Land Mines played a tragic part toward the end of operations which was 3rd March 1970. The “Grey” Eighth Battalion received a citation for their brave efforts. Further information can be had at the Canberra War Memorial Website.

183 Recce Flight – New Guinea

A number of Viet Vets joined the Unit post-Vietnam. Mark Fletcher who resides there had the

183 Flight Banners produced in Hoa Chi Minh City. His father in law Khiet [Kit] found a co-operative printing company who translated the instruction with assistance of his sister in law Tu [Two]. His father in law on motorbike then carried the completed banners 16 kilometres return back to Thu Duc [Two Dook] district. Mark was most grateful.

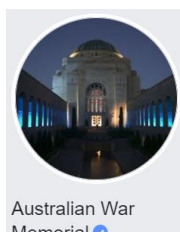
AAAA Reunion, Maroochydore, 23-25 Oct 2020
